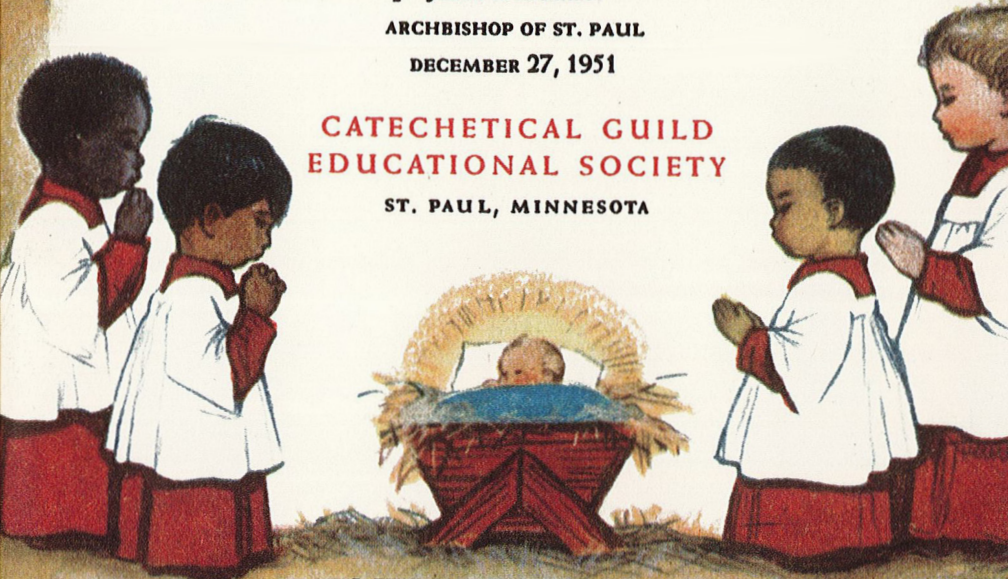
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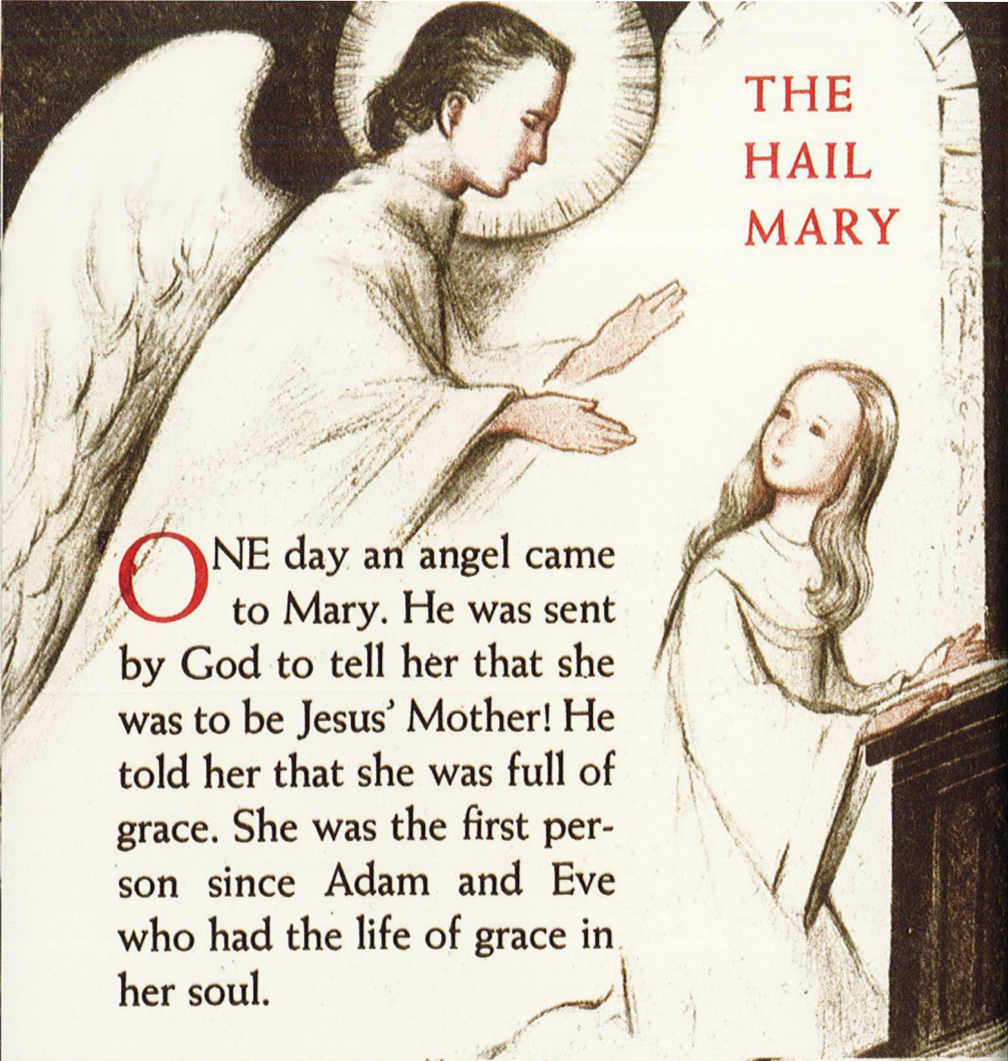


GOD the Father is the Creator. That means He made the earth and everything out of nothing. He made us, too, and He loves us. Jesus is His Son.

In the Name of the Father and of the Son



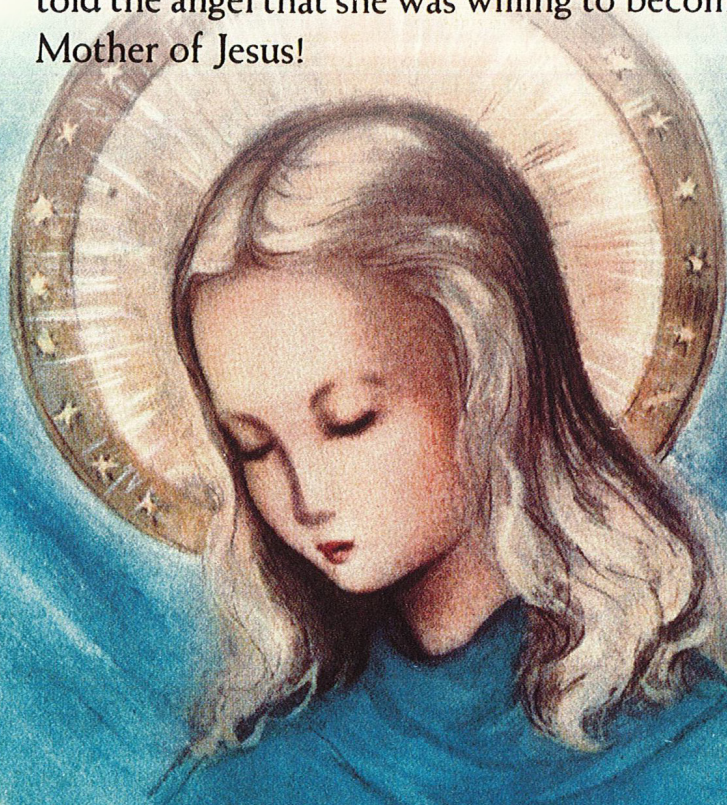


THE HAIL MARY

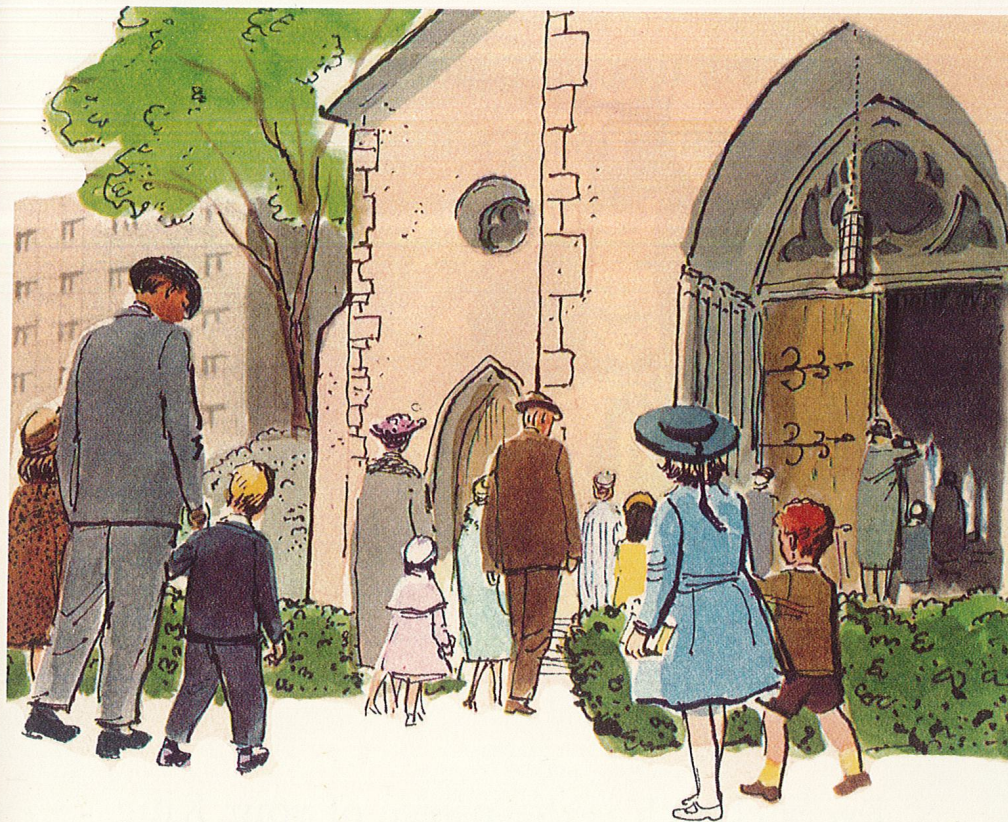

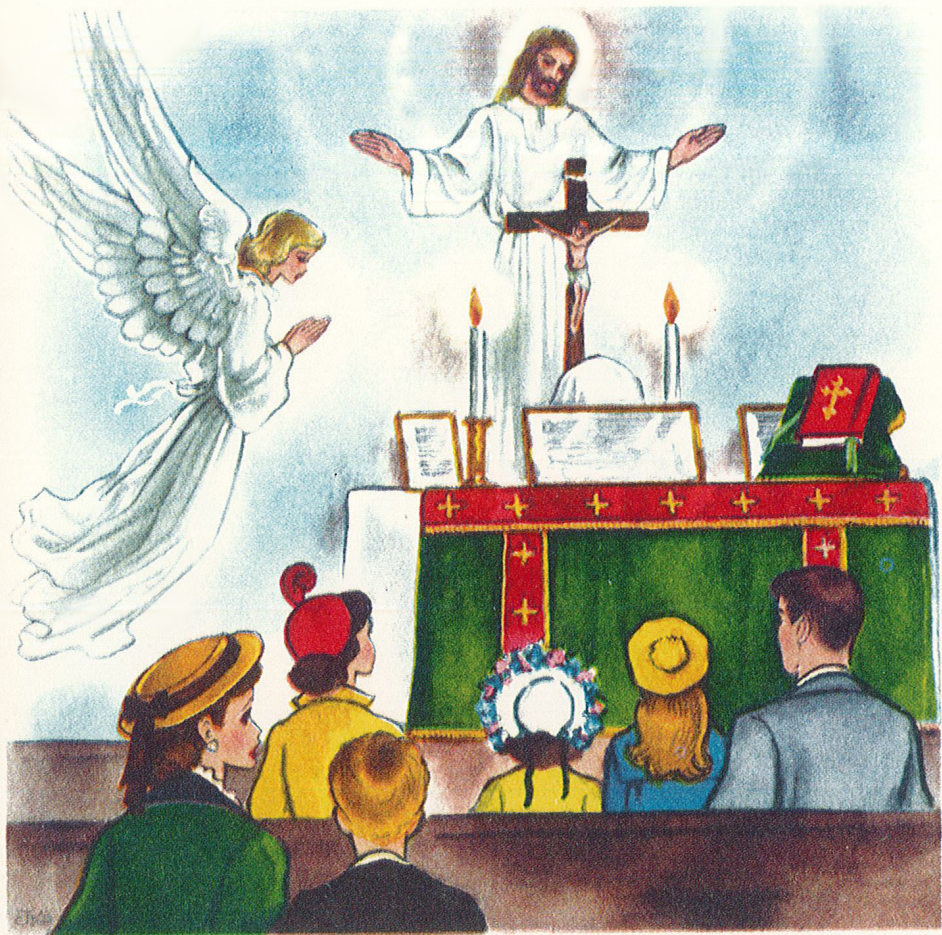

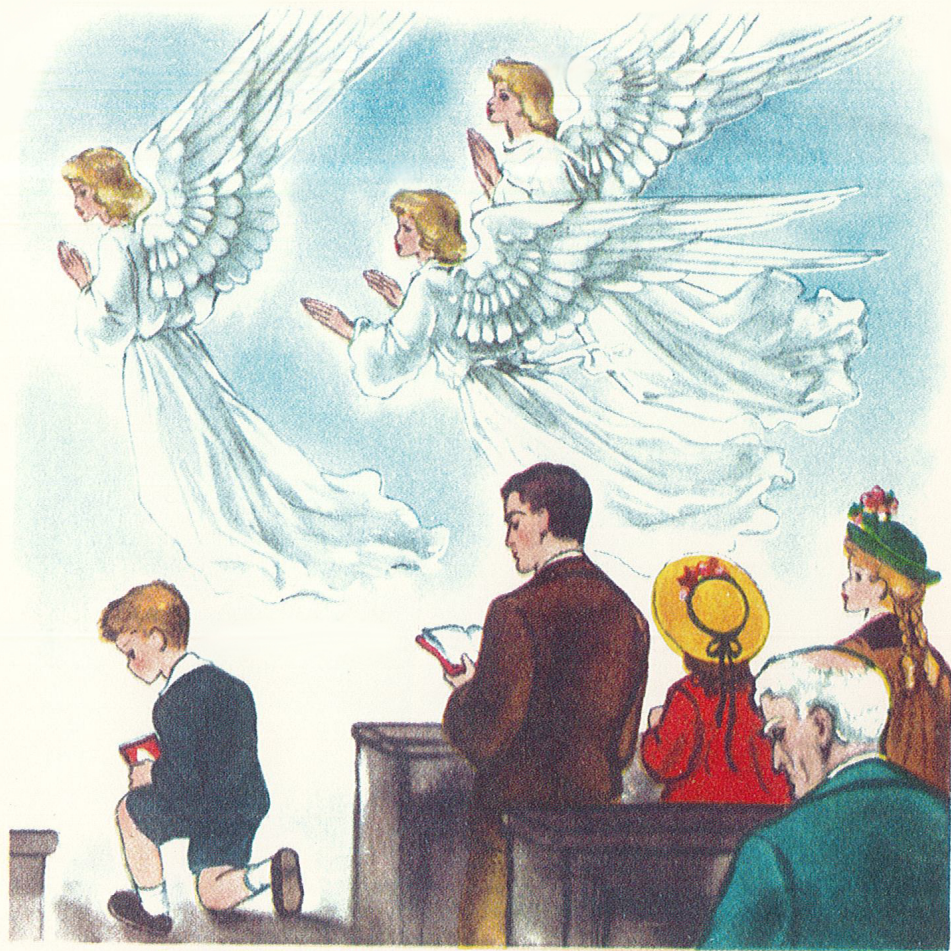
